FORMER POSTAL EMPLOYEE SENTENCED IN THEFT FROM POST OFFICE

– Paducah man sentenced for stealing from the post office

PADUCAH, KY - United States Attorney Candace G. Hill of the Western District of Kentucky announced today that **James Moore**, age 57, of Paducah, Kentucky, was sentenced by United States Magistrate Judge David King on Tuesday, November 10, 2009, on eleven counts of misappropriation of postal funds.

Moore previously plead guilty to stealing money from the Avondale Kentucky Postal Station from July 2008 through December 2008. At the time, Moore had been employed as a sales associate for the Avondale U.S. Post Office. The total loss is estimated at less than \$1,000.

Moore was sentenced to two years probation on each count to run concurrently. As a part of his probation, Moore is required to serve 20 days in federal custody. He was also order to pay restitution to the U.S. Postal Service.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Lettricea Jefferson-Webb, and it was investigated by the United States Postal Service, Office of the Inspector General.
