INDIANOLA WOMAN SENTENCED IN EMBEZZLEMENT FROM THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE

Des Moines, IA - Kimberly Sue Nordhagen, 47, of Indianola, Iowa, was sentenced today to twelve months and one day for embezzling funds from the United States Postal Service, announced United States Attorney Nicholas A. Klinefeldt. United States District Court Judge Ronald E. Longstaff also required Nordhagen to serve two years supervised release after the completion of her sentence and make a \$100 payment to the Crime Victims Fund.

Nordhagen was further ordered to make full restitution to the United States Postal Service of the funds she embezzled. Nordhagen had been employed as a clerk in the West Suburban Station in Clive, Iowa. During the time period from January, 2004 until March 2009, she converted money orders and cash transactions to her own use in the amount of \$244,161.91.

This case was investigated by the U.S. Postal Inspection Service, and prosecuted by the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Southern District of Iowa.
