FORMER POSTAL EMPLOYEE SENTENCED TO PROBATION FOR DESTROYING MAIL

Madison, Wis. - Stephen P. Sinnott, Acting United States Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin, announced that Veronica Minor, 45, of Boyceville, Wis., was sentenced today by Chief U.S. District Judge Barbara Crabb to one year of probation for destroying mail. Minor pleaded guilty to this charge on September 23, 2009.

In January 2009, while Ms. Minor was an employee of the U.S. Postal Service at the Baldwin, Wis. Post Office, she opened mail and took items from it, including a gift card she used at Walmart.

The charges against Minor were the result of an investigation conducted by the U.S. Postal Service, Office of the Inspector General. The prosecution of the case has been handled by Assistant U.S. Attorney Elizabeth Altman.
